For the past few years, Gillian's work in California has focused on supporting successful implementation of the state's housing-related Medi-Cal resources to ensure people experiencing or at risk of homelessness can access CalAIM benefits and services such as Enhanced Care Management, Community Supports, and Transitional Rent.
